## **Job Opportunity: Repair Specialist (Handy Person)**

### **Who We Are**

The Mikisew Cree First Nation (Mikisew) has lived on the ancestral lands of the Athabasca Delta and Wood Buffalo National Park in northeastern Alberta since time immemorial. The lives of our members are linked to the land and to a close understanding of traditions, history and a natural way of life. Many of our members live in the hamlet of Fort Chipewyan, and our traditional lands range over a large portion of Athabasca oil sands deposits. For nearly 30 years, Mikisew Group, our wholly owned business arm, has worked toward the long-term, sustainable economic progress of our Nation and its members through employment and significant investments in education, training, social programs and infrastructure.

Mikisew Cree First Nation is seeking a skilled and reliable Repair Specialist (Handy person) to join our community-based team. As a Repair Specialist (Handyperson), you will be responsible for performing a variety of maintenance and repair tasks to ensure the proper functioning and upkeep of our facilities, buildings, and infrastructure.

### **Who You Are**

We are currently seeking a Repair Specialist for Mikisew's multiple properties. The successful candidate will be responsible for maintaining and repairing all the common areas and various buildings within the community. This is a full-time position.

- Conduct regular inspections of buildings, facilities, rental units and equipment to identify maintenance needs.
- Perform general maintenance and repair tasks, including but not limited to basic plumbing, carpentry, and painting.
- Repair and replace faulty equipment, fixtures, or parts.
- Assist with minor construction projects and renovations as required.
- Respond to repair requests in a timely and efficient manner.
- Yard maintenance
- Ensure compliance with safety regulations and standards.
- Keep accurate records of maintenance and repair activities.
- Collaborate with other team members and contractors to complete projects.
- Other duties as assigned.

- Proven experience as Handy person, or similar role.
- Strong knowledge of repair techniques, tools, and equipment.

- Willing to work flexible schedule.
- Ability to speak and/or understand the Cree language (or another applicable First Nation language) would be beneficial.
