Who We Are

The Mikisew Cree First Nation (Mikisew) has lived on the ancestral lands of the Athabasca Delta and Wood Buffalo National Park in northeastern Alberta since time immemorial. The lives of our members are linked to the land and to a close understanding of traditions, history and a natural way of life. Many of our members live in the hamlet of Fort Chipewyan, and our traditional lands range over a large portion of Athabasca oil sands deposits. For nearly 30 years, our wholly owned business arm has worked toward the long-term, sustainable economic progress of our Nation and its members through employment and significant investments in education, training, social programs and infrastructure.

We are currently seeking a reliable and vigilant individual to join our team as a Camp Security Guard. As a Camp Security Guard, you will be responsible for ensuring the safety and security of the camp, facilities, and campers. You will play a vital role in maintaining a secure and welcoming environment for all campers and staff members.

Who You Are

- Patrol the camp on foot or in a designated vehicle to deter and detect any unauthorized activity or safety hazards.
- Monitor and control access points to the camp, ensuring that only authorized individuals enter the premises.
- Conduct regular inspections of the camp, including restrooms, and recreational areas, to identify any safety concerns or maintenance issues.
- Respond promptly and appropriately to any security or safety incidents, including emergencies, accidents, or disturbances.
- Collaborate with camp management and staff to develop and implement security protocols and emergency response procedures.
- Assist campers and visitors by providing information, directions, and assistance as needed.
- Enforce camp rules and regulations to maintain a safe and enjoyable experience for all campers and visitors.
- Maintain accurate records of security activities, incidents, and daily logs.

Qualifications

- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Proven experience in security, law enforcement, or a related field is preferred.
- Excellent observation and surveillance skills.
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to remain calm and respond quickly and effectively in emergency situations.
- Physical fitness and ability to walk or stand for long periods.
- Familiarity with first aid and CPR procedures is a plus.
- Ability to work flexible hours, including weekends and holidays, as the camp operates 24/7 during the season.

Other Requirements

- Possess valid Class 5 AB driver's license and own or access to a vehicle.
- Willingness and ability to work after hours and/or weekends when required.
- Willing to work flexible schedule.
- Must provide and possess a clear criminal record.
- Ability to speak and/or understand the Cree language (or another applicable First Nation language) would be beneficial.
